We are pleased to announce the 2008 *Parkmont Poetry Festival* and to enlist your help in gathering submissions of student work. This year marks the 26th anniversary of the Festival, an endeavor that we launched in the belief that the untapped voices of young poets in our community deserve recognition. Their efforts to find music and meaning in their experience are what Parkmont School celebrates with this event.

Open to any student in grades six through twelve at a District of Columbia public, private or charter school, the Festival will honor forty finalists – twenty from middle schools and twenty from upper schools – at a reading and awards ceremony on the Parkmont School grounds, May 10, 2008 at 2 p.m. A panel of distinguished area poets, led by Reuben Jackson, will select the semi-finalists and then the finalists. The deadline for submissions is March 3, 2008.
